COMMANDER'S CORNER: We were able to generate sufficient funding, combined with a new vendor's bench cost estimate, to be able to offer a donation of two OCS Memorial benches to Lackland AFB. Comptroller Joe Scarlett has done a good job counting and trying to grow our money, and we are in reasonably good financial shape heading into the November Reunion event. Mike Annast is now overseeing the Memorial Bench project. He is making slow but steady progress. Bob Karre had to pick up the Museum Project, but is having difficulty finding support from local San Antonio OCs and/or identifying OCS memorabilia for the display. He did get the approval from the Lackland Museum Foundation group to establish such a display and once we can identify the desired contents and material costs, we should be able to fund the project.

REUNION UPDATES:

HOTEL: If you are planning to attend this November in Tucson, please get your hotel reservations in now (see page three), as a large bike race event is coming to Tucson the following weekend and those early arriving racers are eating up any rooms available. If we need additional rooms, we have made arrangements with the Riverpark Inn, 10 minutes away from the primary hotel. The rate there will be \$89, and their phone number is 1-800-351-1466 or theriverparkinn.com

TRANSPORTATION: Due to major construction on I-10, directions to the reunion hotel have changed. If you are coming from the North on I-10, take Exit 254 (Prince Road) and continue on the frontage road that parallels I-10 until St Mary's Road. Turn left there, go under the Freeway, and turn right onto Granada Ave. and then right again into the hotel parking lot. Coming from the East/South, take Exit 259 to 29th St but stay on the frontage road paralleling I-10 to Broadway and turn right into town, and then left onto Granada. The hotel sign/entrance is 0.4 miles on your left. American Airlines has offered a discount of 5% for reunion attendees. It is not much, but can save you money overall if you book your flight on-line. Telephone or airport counter bookings have service charges (\$10/\$15) that will eat into any savings. They can be reached at 1-800-433-1790 or AA.com, and their reunion discount code is A15N7AE. In conjunction with the AA offer, Avis Rent-A-Car is offering a group discount with unlimited mileage available 7 days before to 7 days after the reunion. Their discount reunion code is AWD: D005150, and they can be reached at 888-754-8878. Additionally, Enterprise Rent-A-Car is offering a discount for cars rented at either Tucson AP or Phoenix Sky Harbor AP. Their reunion code is LB1820, and they can be reached at 520-792-1602, or enterprise.com. If you use the website, the PIN to use is "INN". Finally, for those individuals arriving into Phoenix Sky Harbor AP, and not renting a car, there is Shuttle Masters at 520-320-6666 or at shuttlemasters.com. They charge \$22.50 each way based on a roundtrip.
